Raventós i Blanc obtains B Corp certification with a score of 114.1 points

- **B Corp certification recognises a verified overall impact across areas such as the environment, people, community, governance, and social impact.**
- **This recognition validates a coherent and cross-cutting way of working, based on long-term decision-making and a strong commitment to the territory.**

Sant Sadurní d'Anoia, 18/12/2025 — Raventós i Blanc has obtained **B Corp certification**, the **international recognition** awarded to companies that meet high standards of social and environmental responsibility, governance, and transparency.

The certification process concluded with a score of **114.1 points**, reflecting the **level of rigor** of the criteria met across the different areas assessed, well above the minimum threshold required for certification (80 points).

The evaluation analyses the company's overall impact across five key areas: **environment, people, community, governance, and social impact**. The certification is not a symbolic label, but **a commitment** that entails periodic review and continuous improvement.

In the case of Raventós i Blanc, the score achieved reflects a set of well-established practices that have been part of the project for many years. These include **organic and biodynamic viticulture** aimed at preserving soil life and biodiversity, as well as **a land management approach** that integrates vineyard, forest, river, and wildlife as a single living system.

The assessment also considered criteria related to how the project is organised and how work is carried out on a daily basis, along with the implementation of **sustainability-oriented practices** such as **waste reduction**, resource optimisation, energy efficiency, and responsible management of the **environmental** impacts associated with winery operations.

Regarding **social impact**, the certification process took into account initiatives such as **Ciutat Nua**, Raventós i Blanc's solidarity project developed in collaboration with the **Can Brians 2** penitentiary centre. Sales of this wine are used to cover the salaries of the individuals participating in the project from Can Brians 2, with the aim of supporting their training and **labour reintegration**.

With this certification, Raventós i Blanc becomes **part of the international B Corp community** of companies working to generate measurable positive impact beyond financial results.

Raventós i Blanc has one of the longest documented winemaking traditions in the world. Since 1497, twenty-one generations of the Raventós family have worked this land of



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vineyards and forest in the Conca del Riu Anoia. Five centuries of dedication to cultivation and a lineage tied to this land generation after generation.

The Raventós i Blanc estate comprises 90 hectares and 44 vineyard plots planted with indigenous grape varieties, within an area shaped by a distinctive microclimate marked by the Anoia River, a lake, two streams, and the Serral hill, as well as a biodiversity that makes it unique.

Raventós i Blanc's commitment is to produce wines that are a faithful reflection of the plot, the grape variety, and the vintage. The vineyard, authenticity, attention to detail, and purity form its core foundation.

Pepe Raventós represents the 21st generation cultivating the estate according to organic and biodynamic farming principles. Faithful to tradition, he places the relationship between human beings and nature at the centre of his philosophy at the estate.
